

MPA Graduation Rates

The MPA degree is designed to be a two-year (four semesters in total) program for a full-time student. 94 new students enrolled into the MPA program during the 2019-2020 academic year. Of the 53 students that initially enrolled in the 2014-2015 cohort, 41 students graduated within four years. Approximately 60% of our students are working during their studies and take fewer classes each term, and thus take longer to graduate.

- Of students who matriculated in the 2014-15 academic year, 77.36 percent of students completed the program in four years. Among those who completed, 63.41 percent completed in two years, 29.27 percent completed in three years, and 7.32 percent completed in four years.
