

MPA Graduation Rates

The MPA degree is designed to be a two-year (four semesters in total) program for a full-time student. 262 new students enrolled into the MPA program during the 2020-2021 academic year. Of the 59 students that initially enrolled in the 2015-2016 cohort, 55 students graduated within four years. Approximately 60% of our students are working during their studies and take fewer classes each term, and thus take longer to graduate.

- Of students who matriculated in the 2015-16 academic year, 93.22 percent of students completed the program within four years. Among those students, 61.02 percent completed in two years, 28.81 percent completed in three years, and 3.39 percent completed in four years.
