

MPA Graduation Rates

The MPA degree is designed to be a two-year (four semesters in total) program for a full-time student. 120 new students enrolled into the MPA program during the 2021-2022 academic year. Of the 50 students that initially enrolled in the 2017-2018 cohort, 39 students graduated within four years. Approximately 74% of our students are working during their studies and take fewer classes each term, and thus take longer to graduate.

- Of students who matriculated in the 2017-18 academic year, 90.7 percent of students completed the program within four years. Among those students, 44 percent completed in two years, 68 percent completed in three years, and 78 percent completed in four years.
