### Administrative Rights Policy for College Computing Resources

As a general matter of policy no COSSPP faculty, staff or students are granted administrative rights to college computers connected to the FSU network. This is a campus wide policy in general and is deemed necessary to minimize security risks. In rare cases, admin rights are granted to faculty via a non-domain local account that has limited and timed accessibility to provide researchers working on special projects with flexibility to do after hours' work. This situation is managed by the IT director and staff on a case by case basis. The person(s) doing research that might require special security privileges should submit a ticket at this website: **[coss.fsu.edu/support](https://coss.fsu.edu/support)** detailing their needs for additional computing flexibility. Staff will schedule a meeting to discuss the options and go forward.

Please note that it is University IT policy not to grant administrative rights to employees outside of the IT groups. This is a prudent policy that will be adhered to by the college in all cases.
