MPA Graduation Rates

The MPA degree is designed to be a two-year (four semesters in total) for a full-time student.

- Of students who matriculated in the 2013-14 academic year, 72 percent of students completed the program in four years. Among those who completed, 50 percent completed in two years, 17 percent completed in three years, and 5 percent completed in four years.
- Of students who matriculated in the 2014-15 academic year, 93 percent of students completed the program in four years. Among those who completed, 59 percent completed in two years, 28 percent completed in three years, and 6 percent completed in four years.
